Maxima's Indigenous Employment Program has recently developed the 'Maxima Cadetship Program'. We will support host employers to offer entry-level professional experience to First Nations Students with the goal of developing genuine pathways and improving university completion rates.


Our First Nations Cadetship Program aims to provide:

- The provision of genuine professional development opportunities for First Nations university students
- Support for employers to achieve First Nations employmentgoals through the offer of professional, paid work experience and employment opportunities
- Increased completion rates for First Nations University studentsthrough remuneration, employment pathways and mentoring and support
- The development of long-term relationships between First
 Nations university students and employers, including networking opportunities hosted by Maxima
- Strengthened long-term relationships between employers anduniversities, driven by a mutual desire to provide genuine pathways for First Nations peoples.

The Maxima Cadetship Program will see second and third year First Nations tertiary students enter into a 12 month cadetship program with host employers across a range of professions.

Working closely with tertiary institutions, Maxima will continue to provide services connecting students to employers, taking the stress out of recruitment and paperwork.

Maxima is a not-for-profit community based Australian organisation, and for more than 35 years, has worked with individuals and organisations to provide comprehensive recruitment, training, employment and NDIS support services. We advocate for an inclusive and diverse workforce and support equal employment and learning opportunities for everyone.
